Global sales of pet products in 2016 were $\$ 103.5$ billion; a $4.7 \%$ increase over 2015 , which is an enormous growth rate.
9 Why are we spending so much money on our animal companions? Well, basically because we seem to think pets are people and treat them 10as such. A survey conducted in 2015 found that $95 \%$ of US pet owners consider their pets part of the family -up from $88 \%$ in 2007 . And it's not 11 just Americans; another survey this year claims that $56 \%$ of Brits plan to spend more money on Christmas presents for their pets than on gifts 12 for their human family.
13 Nowhere is the humanisation of pets more clearly reflected than in their diets. Despite the fact that dogs will happily eat anything, their 14 meals have become a gourmet affair -the ingredients of which tend to say more about the taste of their owners than animal appetites.
