Ejercicio 1. (Calificación máxima: 2 puntos)

Are the following statements TRUE or FALSE? Copy the evidence from the text. No marks are given for only TRUE or FALSE.

- a) In Shakespeare's times, theatre viewers were forbidden to eat during performances.
- b) Theatre audiences today have easy access to information on how to behave properly.

Solución:

- a) False. "Sixteenth-century England was renowned for its noisy audiences who, in public outdoor theatres, could sleep, eat and drink heartily all while taking in Shakespeare's newest work." (P. 2, L. 11 – 12)
- b) True. "Audience etiquette guides, which cover everything from dress code and late arrivals to coughing and unwrapping candies, are widely available today." (P. 3, L. 17 – 18)

- a) Which two changes did Mr. Garrick implement in his theatre?
- b) What did Patti Lupone do during the performance in 2015?

- b) Actress Patti Lupone stopped acting when a spectator's phone rang and took it away from them.
