Ejercicio 1. (Calificación máxima: 2 puntos)

Indicate whether TWO of the following statements are True, False or the information is Not Given in the text (T/F/NG). In true and false cases, copy the complete sentence that contains the evidence which justifies your answer. No marks are given for only TRUE or FALSE.

- a) Home education has become increasingly unpopular in the last decade.
- b) In flexi-schooling, pupils learn using electronic devices as well as traditional textbooks.
- c) One of the reasons why parents choose homeschooling is that they can select the learning contents themselves.

Solución:

- a) False. "There has been a notable rise in parents choosing to home educate their children over recent years, particularly since the COVID pandemic." (P. 1, L. 1 – 2).

- c) True. "Some families prefer to home educate so they can teach the curriculum they wish and give their children a personalised education." (P.3, L. 16 – 18).

- b) How are people getting to know better about homeschooling?

Ejercicio 5. (Calificación máxima: 3 puntos)

Write about 150 to 200 words on ONE of the following questions.

- a) What are the advantages and disadvantages of taking online lessons? Discuss.
- b) Your friend Susan, who will be going to university next year, has sent you an e-mail asking for your opinion on whether she should study in her home country or abroad instead. Reply with an informal e-mail giving your advice. DO NOT SIGN OR IDENTIFY YOUR EMAIL.

Solución:

a) Online lessons are an increasingly popular tool for teachers and students worldwide. However, they are also the object of a lot of debates about the quality of teaching and learning and the resources needed to have this option.

To start there, online learning is not widely available as an alternative to in-person classes, since there are many students who do not own a computer or have a stable wifi connection. These two things are essential in order to benefit from the experience.
