Solución:

The mere idea of a world where humans do not eat natural food seems strange, and it reminds me of some dystopian literature or films in which our planet is in danger of running out of natural resources or society is immersed in communal delirium. In fact, science fiction reflects our anxieties, and nowadays, these do not look irrational as long as some scientists warn of the potential serious health effects of the artificial food additives we already eat. By contrast, some argue that it is an exaggeration because artificial food pass quality controls. According to this point of view, our fears are baseless while the potential benefits of producing artificial food are huge (animal welfare and the reduction of pollution). Therefore, they claim that the option of artificial food should not be rejected.

It is universally acknowledged that scientific development means enormous benefits, but it also involves some risks. Although I think it might be helpful for us to research with artificial food, I would not like to live in a world without the possibility of eating natural food.
