<u>Ejercicio 1.</u> (Calificación máxima: 2 puntos)

Are the following statements TRUE or FALSE? Copy the evidence from the text. No marks are given for only TRUE or FALSE

- a) Scientists have invented a device that alerts you with a visual signal when you are having a tedious conversation.
- b) The new watch, as it is now, collects information from both parties involved in the conversation.

Solución:

- a) False (Paragraph 1 Line 2) "Well, help could be at hand from a watch that gives a warning buzz (...)"
- b) False (Paragraph 2 Line 15-16) "(...) but later versions could also analyse audio from all sides of a conversation (...)"

Ejercicio 2. (Calificación máxima: 2 puntos)

In your own words and based on the ideas in the text, answer the following questions. Do not copy from the text.

- a) What kind of information does the new watch need to analyse conversations?
- b) In what ways might this new invention be useful in the coming years?

Solución:

- a) This new device collects physical data from the speaker, such as the heart rate, the blood pressure, temperature and movement and combines them with audio recordings in order to analyse how the conversation is going.
- b) This new technology may be useful in the future to help people in social situation, such as job interviews, but also to help those who have special needs, such as people suffering from autism or Asperger's syndrome.
